# Introduction

- Malayalam class is facilitated by HTCS Education program, and is completely run by volunteers
- > We have been serving the community for 29 years now
- Currently, the program has about 50 students assisted by five dedicated teachers

# Class schedule

- Malayalam program runs in Fall Session September through December and in Spring session February through June
- Classes run every Sunday 2pm to 3:30pm

## **Class Overview**

- > There are three levels for Malayalam class
  - ▶ Level 1
  - ▶ Level 2
  - ► Level 3
- > There will be regular homework for students at the discretion of the teachers.
- > Top performing students and students maintaining a good attendance record are recognized by HTCS during Vidyalaya Day.
- > Each session will have at least one test for every level.

# Celebrations&activities

- Malayalam Class students will celebrate:
  - Holiday party in December
  - Vishu in April
  - Vidyalaya Day in June
  - Class Picnic in June/July
  - Onam

## Level 1

- Introduction to Malayalam language
- Introduce simple Malayalam words
  - Colors, Body Parts and so on
- ► Talk simple sentences including these words
  - eg Amma vannu ; ila veenu
- ► Trace the Malayalam letters
- Learn to count
- Learn Small Poems
- Games/Activity
- Homework every week

### Level2 and level3

- > Follows Malayalam Mission's textbook Kanikkonna
- > Emphasis on Speaking, Writing and Reading
- > Introduce grammar concepts
- > Introduce children to the history, culture and festivals of Kerala
- Games/Activity
- > Homework every week
