'Naram' means water and "Aayanam' means Sthiti. The one who finds His residence upon these waters (Ocean) is Narayana. 'Naram' also refers to knowledge – thus Narayana is the fountain-head of knowledge. In this Kaliyuga, Sri Venkateswara Swamy is the Ananta-Narayana – the one who symbolizes infinity. Therefore, worshiping the Swamy with water from one thousand 'Kalasas' is blissful. In these 'Kalasas' waters, holy rivers and divine medicinal powers are invoked through special prayers. Performing the Swamy's SAHASRA KALASABHISHEKAM with these purified and powerful waters bestows all round welfare, blessings of progeny, longevity, health and happiness, upon us.
